Please Note: *All presenters are required to register for the Convention by October 1st. If not registered by that date, the session will be dropped from the program.*

Session Types

THEME: The Power of Connection: 125 Years of Bridging Math and Science

Research Sessions (25 or 50 minutes): This session is designed for the presentation of a research project or study. Audience members will have time at the end of a presentation to ask questions of the presenter.

Regular Sessions (25 or 50 minutes): This session is designed to present information on projects, course innovations, program innovations or other science and mathematics initiatives. Audience members will have time at the end of a presentation to ask questions of the presenter.

Workshop Sessions (75 minutes): This session is designed to engage participants in an interactive environment to explore mathematics, science, STEM research, projects, or initiatives.

Poster Sessions: Present your research study, course innovation or other project. The poster session will last 90 minutes and consist of many presenters. Poster sessions allow attendees to speak with the presenters on a one-to-one basis.

Three Minute Thesis: Present your research and its significance in three minutes. This session is great for graduate students and other researchers who want to engage the audience in a compelling oration of their research in 180 seconds.
